

Professor Christophe Iselin is a graduate from Geneva University Medical Faculty. After having completed his Swiss Board of Urology in 1993, he started performing laparoscopic surgeries since 1994. He then accomplished a 2 year fellowship period in Uro-oncology and Reconstructive Urology, the latter under the guidance of George Webster, at Duke University Medical Center (Durham, North Carolina. USA). Since 1998, he is Head of the Division of Urologic Surgery at Geneva University Hospital, and has authored over 150 publications, half of them in peer-reviewed journals. His major urological interests at this time are robotic surgery (over 800 operations), Laser treatment of benign prostatic hyperplasia, prostate cancer and reconstructive urology, with a particular interest in male urethral stricture disease. In the latter field, so as in robotic surgery, he has been invited to perform internationally (congress live surgery sessions). In the robotic field for over 11 years, Prof Iselin has organized several post-graduate courses in this topic at the Multidisciplinary Center of Surgical Teaching in Geneva. In 2013, he created the Prostate Cancer Center of Geneva University Hospital, which has received a quality label since 2014 by the German Cancer Society (DKG). He is past President of the Swiss Urological Society.
